Susan G. Komen History:

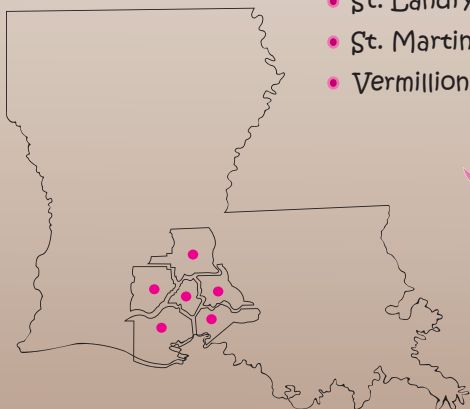

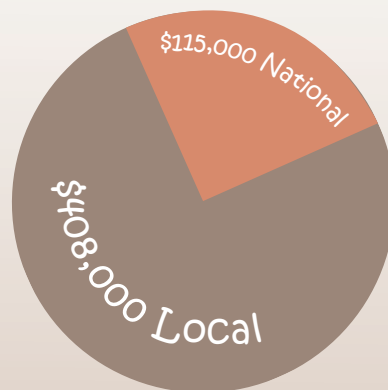
